have got / has got – έχω

- Χρησιμοποιούμε το **have got / has got**
 - για να πούμε ότι κάτι ανήκει σε κάποιον. I **have got** a red bag.
 - για να περιγράψουμε κάποιον ή κάτι. Marios **has got** brown eyes.
- Χρησιμοποιούμε **have got** με τα **I, you, we** και **they**.
I **have got** blue eyes. You **have got** a small nose.
We **have got** two kittens. They **have got** two dogs.
- Χρησιμοποιούμε **has got** στο τρίτο ενικό πρόσωπο (**he, she, it**).
He **has got** two wings. She **has got** a cat. It **has got** a tail.
- Για να σχηματίσουμε την άρνηση, προσθέτουμε το **not** ανάμεσα στο **have / has** και το **got**.
Rabbits **have not got** long tails. He **has not got** brown hair.

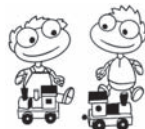
